विषय : मौजूदा टैरिफ की वसूली 31.03.2025 तक जारी रखने के लिए अंतरिम व्यवस्था। Subject: Interim arrangement to levy the existing tariffs to continue till 31.03.2025.

AERA, vide Order No. 40/2023-24 dated 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2024 inter-alia, allowed the following airports/airport operators to levy tariffs, on interim basis, for a period of 06 (six) months w.e.f. 01.04.2024 to 30.09.2024, or, till the determination of regular tariff for their respective control periods, whichever is earlier:

- 2. The Authority reviewed the position in respect of determination of regular tariffs in respect of above airports and observed as under:
  - Tariff Orders for airport namely Jaipur, Guwahati, Trivandrum, Coimbatore and Shirdi has already been issued.
  - ii. Multi Year Tariff Proposals in respect of Delhi, Mumbai, Varanasi & Amritsar airport for the Control period (01.04.2024 to 31.03.2029) and Indore Airport for the Control Period (01.04.2023 to 31.03.2028) is under examination and the completion of tariff determination exercise is likely to take some time.
- iii. Further, Port Blair airport, a Civil Enclave, has recently been declared as a Major Airport, based on the designated capacity of more than 3.5 MPPA as defined under Section 2 (i) of AERA Act 2008. In this regard, the Multi Year Tariff Proposal is yet to be received from AAI.

3. In view of the above, it is evident that the final determination of tariff for aeronautical services in respect of Delhi, Mumbai, Varanasi, Amritsar and Indore airport is likely to take some time. The tariff determination process of Port Blair Airport will be commenced upon receipt of MYTP from AAI, which is still awaited. Accordingly, the Authority decides as under:

To extend the existing tariff, as applicable as on 30.09.2024, on interim basis, for a further period of 06 (six) months w.e.f. 01.10.2024 to 31.03.2025 or till the determination of regular tariffs for the relevant Control Period, whichever is earlier, in respect of the airports/airport operators as given in table 1 below:

#### **ORDER**

Upon careful consideration of the material available on records, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1)(a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, hereby orders that:

- (i) The **Airport Operators (listed at Sr. No. 1 to 6 of Table-I above)** are allowed to levy the existing tariff, applicable as on 30.09.2024, on interim basis, for a further period of 06 (six) months w.e.f. 01.10.2024 to 31.03.2025, or, till the determination of regular tariff for their respective Control Period, whichever is earlier.
- (ii) The Airport Operators shall ensure compliance of the Order.
