In the matter of determination of Annual Tariff for First, Second, Third and Fourth Tariff Years of the First Control Period in respect of Bird Worldwide Flight Services (India) Private Limited for Providing Ground Handling Services at IGI Airport, New Delhi.

The Authority had considered the Multi Year Tariff Proposal (MYTP) for the first Control Period (i.e. 2011-12 to 2015-16) submitted by M/s Bird Worldwide Flight Services (India) Private Limited (BWFS) in respect of the tariff for the services provided for ground handling at IGI Airport, New Delhi and after due stakeholder consultation, issued Multi Year Tariff Order (MYTO) No. 25/2011-12 on 28.10.2012, ordering that the ground handling services provided by BWFS is "material but competitive" and tariffs for the same shall be determined under a "light touch approach".

2. Thereafter, BWFS submitted their Annual Tariff Proposals ATP(s) for first tariff year (2011-12), second tariff year (2012-13), third tariff year (2013-14) and fourth tariff years (2014-15).

3.1 The Authority considered the submissions made by BWFS and issued Consultation Paper No. 25/2012-13 on 06.11.2012, wherein the ATPs for first, second, third and fourth tariff years were put up for stakeholder comments. The last date for submission of comments was 20.11.2012.

3.2 In response to the said Consultation Paper, comment was received from Delhi International Airport (P) Ltd. (DIAL). DIAL, in its comments has agreed to the proposal contained in the Consultation Paper and requested to approve Annual Tariff Proposals submitted by BWFS.

3.3 The Authority noted that after stakeholder consultation in respect of the Consultation Paper No. 25/2012-13, BWFS has submitted rates for certain activities under ground handling services and mentioned that "..... the *additional services are excluded in the above rates*.....". It was observed that BWFS had not included these additional services and the charges for the same in its ATP, which was placed for stakeholder consultation vide Consultation Paper No. 25/2012-13. This is a material proposal in respect of various Ground Handling activities although BWFS has stated that these services are not regularly used on all flights.

3.4 The Authority noted the list of additional services and observed that the tariff rates for these additional services would need further stakeholder consultation. The tariffs for these would need to be determined based on the outcome of the stakeholder consultation process. The Authority also observed that BWFS had submitted these additional tariff items before issue of the instant Order in respect of the proposal contained in Consultation Paper No. 25/2012-13 dated 06.11.2012. Hence, alternatively BWFS may be permitted to levy these charges for the present - subject to the final determination post stakeholder consultation and in such a case, the revenue received on this account should be accounted for by BWFS separately. In case the final determined rates for these additional services are less than the proposed rates, then BWFS would be required to refund the excess revenue collected till such determination. On balance, the Authority has presently, decaded to determine the tariffs for additional

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services subject to separate accounting and their final determination post stakeholder consultation process being held separately in this regard.

<u>ORDER</u>

4. Upon careful consideration of material available on record, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13 (1) (a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, hereby orders that:

- (i) Tariffs for the first tariff year (w.e.f. 01.04.2011 to 31.03.2012), second tariff year (w.e.f, 01.04.2012 to 31.03.2013), third tariff year (w.e.f. 01.04.2013 to 31.03.2014) and fourth tariff year (w.e.f, 01.04.2014 to 31.03.2015) of the first five year control period, for ground handling services provided by Bird Worldwide Flight Services (India) Private Limited at IGI Airport, New Delhi, are determined as at Annexure I.
- (ii) Tariff for additional services for the first tariff year (w.e.f. 01.04.2011 to 31.03 .2012), second tariff year (w.e.f, 01.04.2012 to 31.03.2013), third tariff year (w.e.f. 01.04.2013 to 31.03.2014) and fourth tariff year (w.e.f, 01.04.2014 to 31.03.2015) of the first five year control period as proposed by BWFS are also determined for the present only as at **Annexure-II**. The proposal for these additional tariff items is being placed separately for stakeholder consultation. The current determination of these tariff items has been done by the Authority for the time being and is subject to the final determination of these additional tariff items. BWFS will maintain a separate account for revenue from these additional tariff items and after final determination of these charges by the Authority, BWFS will have to undertake consequential refund action, if any, based on the rates which may be finally determined post stakeholder consultation in the matter of the additional services, for which Consultation Paper is being issued separately.
