Determination of tariff for the fourth and fifth (2014-15 and 2015-16) tariff years of the first control period.

This Authority, vide Direction No. 04/2010-11 dated 10.01.2011, had issued the Guidelines [The Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Tariff for Services provided for Cargo Facility, Ground Handling and Supply of Fuel to the Aircraft), Guidelines, 2011 prescribing procedures, terms and conditions for determination of tariff for the above mentioned regulated services being provided by Independent Service Provider(s). As per the Guidelines, the service providers are required to submit Multi Year Tariff Proposal (MYTP) for the five year control period and Annual Tariff Proposal (ATP) for individual tariff years of the Control Period.

Accordingly, the Authority had considered the Multi Year Tariff Proposal (MYTP) 2. submitted by Air India SATS Airport Services Pvt. Ltd. (AISATS) for the first control period commencing 01.04.2011 in respect of Cargo Handling Services at Kempegowda International Airport, Bengaluru. After due stakeholder consultation, the Authority issued Multi Year Tariff Order (MYTO) No. 22/2011-12 dated 29.09.2011 wherein, interalia, it was decided that the service provided for cargo handling services, is "material but competitive", hence "light touch approach" be adopted for determination of tariff for the 1st Control period. Pursuant to issue of above, the Authority considered the Annual Tariff Proposal (ATP) for the first, second and third tariff years and after due stakeholder consultation, determined the tariffs vide ATO(s) no. Order No. 44/2012-13 dated 15.02.2013, Order No. 31/2013-14 dated 01.08.2013, Order No. 37/2013-14 dated 03.02.2014. The Authority also issued Order No. 01/2014-15 dated 18.03.2014 for revision of domestic tariff for the third tariff year i.e w.e.f 01.02.2014 to 31.03.2014.

3. AISATS, vide letter no. 2015/L/CHQ/MKT/0020/AERA dated 01.06.2015 submitted ATP for tariff year 2014-15 and 2015-16. Further AISATS, has also submitted Annual Compliance Statement for tariff year 2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-14 as per clause 7.7 of the CGF Guidelines.

ORDER

- 4. Upon careful consideration of material available on record, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1)(a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, hereby orders that:
 - (i) Air India SATS Services Pvt. Ltd. would continue to levy tariffs for the 4th and 5th tariff year at the same level as was approved by Authority vide Order No. 31/2013-14 dated 8.08.2013 & Order No. 01/2014-15 dated 18.03.2014 for providing Cargo Handling Services at Kempegowda International Airport, Bengaluru. (Annexure I).
 - (ii) Air India SATS Service Pvt. Ltd. should submit the MYTP and ATP for the 2nd Control Period well in time as per the Guidelines by incorporating the actual financials of 2014-2015.
