In the matter of Annual Tariff Proposal submitted by M/s Celebi Ground Handling Delhi Private Limited for third tariff year of the first control period providing Ground Handling Services at IGI Airport, New Delhi.

The Authority had considered the Multi Year Tariff Proposal for the first control period of (i.e. 2011-12 to 2015-16) submitted by M/s Celebi Ground Handling Delhi Private Limited (Celebi) in respect of the tariff for the services provided for ground handling at IGI Airport, New Delhi and after due stakeholder Consultation issued Multi Year Tariff Order (MYTO) No. 26/2011-12 dated 28.10.2011, ordering that the ground handling service being rendered by Celebi is "material but competitive" and tariff for the same shall be determined under a "light touch approach". Subsequently Celebi submitted their Annual Tariff Proposal (ATP) for first and second tariff years which were considered by the Authority and after due stakeholder consultation, Annual Tariff Order (ATO) No. 23/2012-13 dated 12.11.2012 was issued, determining the tariff for the first tariff year (2011-12) and second tariff year (2012-13) of the first five year control period.

2. Thereafter, Celebi submitted their ATP for third tariff year (2013-14), vide submission dated 21.02.2013.

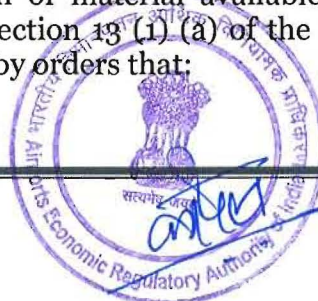
3. The Authority considered the submission made by Celebi and issued Consultation Paper No. 4/2013-14 on 16.04.2013, wherein the ATP for third tariff year was put up for stakeholder consultation. The last date for submission of comments was 30.04.2013.

4. In response to the said Consultation Paper, comments have been received from Delhi International Airport Private Limited (DIAL). DIAL in its comments has requested approval of the ATP for third tariff year submitted by Celebi.

5. The Authority noted the above and observed that as per the MYTO the tariffs in respect of Ground Handling Services provided by Celebi at Delhi Airport are to be determined under Light Touch Approach.

ORDER:

6. Upon careful consideration of material available on record, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13 (1) (a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, hereby orders that:



- (i) The tariff for the Third Tariff Year (01.04.2013 to 31.03.2014) of the first control period for the Ground Handling Services provided by M/s Celebi Ground Handling Delhi Private Limited at IGI Airport, New Delhi is determined, as at per **Annexure - I**.
- (ii) These tariffs will be the maximum tariffs and will be effective from 01.04.2013.
