In the matter of Request for Extension of time for submission of Annual Tariff Proposal for Third Tariff Year and to continue the existing tariff till final determination of tariff for third tariff year by Celebi Delhi Cargo Terminal Management India Private Limited (Celebi) for Cargo Handling Services at IGI Airport, New Delhi.

The Authority had considered the Multi Year Tariff Proposal (MYTP) submitted by M/s Celebi Delhi Cargo Terminal Management India Pvt. Ltd. (Celebi) for the first control period of 5 years starting w.e.f. 01.04.2011 for providing Cargo Handling Services at IGI Airport, New Delhi and after due stakeholder consultation issued a Multi Year Tariff Order No. 14/2011-12 dated 07.10.2011 wherein the Authority decided to adopt light touch approach for determination of the tariff for the 1<sup>st</sup>Control Period w.e.f. 01.04.2011 and also directed Celebi to submit their Annual Tariff Proposal (ATP) for the first tariff year of the first control period for the consideration of the Authority within a period of 75 days of the issue of the order in accordance with the Guidelines.

- 2. Pursuant to the issue of the Multi Year Tariff Order, Celebi submitted their ATP for the first (2011-12) and second (2012-13) tariff year. The Authority vide Order no. 11/2012-13 issued on 03.08.2012, determined the tariffs, for first and second tariff years, for cargo handling services provided by Celebi at IGI Airport, New Delhi.
- 3. As per Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India (Terms and conditions for Determination of Tariff for Services provided for Cargo facility, Ground Handling and Supply of Fuel to the Aircraft) Guidelines 2011, Celebi is required to submit their Annual Tariff Proposal (ATP) for third tariff year to the Authority for its consideration, at least 75 days prior to the start of the Tariff Year.
- 4. In this regard Celebi, vide letter no. nil dated 15.01.2013 requested for extension of time for submission of Annual Tariff Proposal (ATP) for third tariff year i.e. 2013-14, upto 30.04.2013 and also proposed to continue their existing tariff till the date their ATP for third tariff year (2013-14) is approved by the Authority. The Authority has accepted the request of Celebi for extension of time for submission of ATP for third tariff year. Regarding the tariffs for cargo services provided by Celebi, it is observed that the tariffs for the year 2012-13 were determined after stakeholder consultation. Hence, the Authority has considered the request for continuation of

existing tariffs for third tariff year, till final determination of the tariffs (for 3<sup>rd</sup> tariff year) by the Authority.

## ORDER

- 5. Upon careful consideration of material available on record, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13 (1) (a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, hereby orders that:
  - (i) The tariffs as were determined for the second tariff year (FY 2012-13) for cargo handling services provided by M/s Celebi Delhi Cargo Terminal Management India Private Limited, vide Order No. 11/2012-13 dated 03.08.2012 is decided to be valid till final determination of tariffs for the third tariff year of the first control period.
