# AERA/20019/CGF-G/2010-11/Vol-VIII (Part File) Airports Economic Regulatory Authority Of India

### Order No. 09/2020-21

AERA Building, Administrative Complex, Safdarjung Airport, New Delhi – 110003

Date of Issue: 1st June, 2020

In the matter of Order No. 20/2019-20 dated 03.01.2020 regarding Economic Regulation of Aeronautical Services provided by Independent Service providers of Cargo facility, Ground Handling and Supply of Fuel to the aircraft - Interim arrangement to continue the levy of existing tariffs beyond 30.06.2020 for the Second Control Period.

This is regarding interim arrangement of levy of tariff for the period beyond 30.06.2020 of the Second Control Period in respect of Independent Service Provider(s) mentioned in the table below.

- 2. In respect of the above ISPs, the Authority noted the following:
  - a) The Authority has already allowed them to continue to levy the existing tariff as applicable on 31.12.2019 up to 30.06.2020 on an interim basis vide Order No. 20/2019-20 dated 03.01.2020.
  - b) M/s Celebi and M/s BWFS have submitted their tariff proposal vide letters dated 31.12.2019 and 04.03.2020 respectively for the period FY 2019-20 (part period) and FY 2020-21 of the second control period. However, the Authority has observed that the Annual Tariff Proposals submitted are incomplete.
  - c) Both ISP's have not submitted the copy of the concession agreement which is an important document required by the Authority to process the ATPs.
  - d) M/s BWFS along with its proposal has annexed DIAL's letter dated 04.02.2020 wherein ceiling rates for each category of aircrafts, have been mentioned. The Authority noted that fixing rates by DIAL is improper as AERA is the Statutory Authority to regulate and fix/determine the tariff for provision of aeronautical services. Clarifications have been sought from DIAL in this regard which are awaited.
  - e) M/s BWFS has not conducted user consultation for the proposed hike in tariff.

- f) M/s Celebi has conducted user consultation way back in the year 2018 which cannot be considered relevant at this stage.
- 3. In view of above, the Authority is not able to proceed with the tariff determination, hence in order to avoid any regulatory vacuum decides that the above Independent Service Providers be allowed to continue the levy of the existing tariffs as on 30.06.2020 for a period of 09 (nine) months w.e.f. 01.07.2020 to 31.03.2021 or till determination of tariffs for the remaining period of the second control period whichever is earlier.

#### ORDER

To avoid any regulatory vacuum in respect of the tariffs being levied by the regulated entities, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1) of the Airport Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008 hereby orders that:-

- (i) M/s Bird Worldwide Flight Services (India) Private Limited is allowed to continue to levy tariff as applicable as on 30.06.2020 for a further period of 09 (nine) months i.e. w.e.f 01.07.2020 to 31.03.2021 or till determination of tariffs by the Authority whichever is earlier (as Annexure-A).
- (ii) M/s Celebi Airports Services India Private Limited is also allowed to continue to levy tariff as applicable as on 30.06.2020 for a further period of 09 (nine) months i.e. w.e.f 01.07.2020 to 31.03.2021 or till determination of tariffs by the Authority whichever is earlier (as Annexure-B).
- (iii) The Airport Operator may ensure timely submission of proposals/information by Independent Service Providers at the IGI Airport, New Delhi and also ensure compliance of the Order.
