In the matter of Economic Regulation of Cargo Operations provided by Kannur International Airport Limited (KIAL) – Ad Hoc Tariff Order for Cargo Services.

1. KIAL Submissions:

- 1.1 M/s KIAL started Airport Operations at Kannur Airport in December 2018. The current proposal from M/s KIAL (Kannur International Airport Ltd.) is for ad hoc determination of tariffs for their Cargo Operations, proposed to commence shortly at Kannur Airport. KIAL has sought ad hoc cargo tariffs for the period up to March 2021.
- 1.2 KIAL vide initial submissions vide letter dated 05.06.2020 sought ad hoc tariffs up to 31.12.2020. Clarification was sought regarding the status of Department of Customs approval. KIAL in its subsequent submissions vide mail dated 29.06.2020 sought ad hoc tariffs up to 31st March 2021 and further via mail dated 26.08.2020 also submitted the copy of approval from Department of Customs.
- 1.3 M/s Kannur International Airport (KIAL) has submitted copy of the approval of Commissioner of Customs, Kochi, vide letter no. C.No.VIII/48/31/2019_CCP.Tech, dated 24.07.2020, appointing KIAL as the Customs Cargo Service Provider for Custody of import/export goods at Air Cargo Complex, Kannur International Airport for a period of 2 years up to 24.07.2022.
- 1.4 KIAL has submitted that, it proposes to operate both Domestic and International Cargo Operations on its own through an "O & M Operator" arrangement for which a fee will be paid by Airport Operator (KIAL). M/s Cargo Service Centre Pvt. Ltd. has been appointed as the O & M Contractor for cargo operations for a period of two (02) years (KIAL letter dated 19.02.2020 to M/s CSC).
- 1.5 It has been further stated that KIAL has already constructed a Cargo Terminal Building of 1134 sq. m. at a cost of Rs.6.50 Crores and the Terminal has space demarcated for both domestic and international operations. It is also stated that Kannur Airport has also commenced construction of an International Cargo Complex with an area of 5854.50 sqm near the ATC Block for future operations. The Cargo Terminal Site Layout & Plan is submitted along with the proposal. Presently, <u>KIAL is not declared as a "point of call for foreign carriers.</u>"

1.6 M/s KIAL has approached AERA for ad hoc cargo tariffs pending submission of detailed Tariff Proposal by them for regular determination of tariffs in this regard. M/s KIAL has proposed that the current prevailing tariffs equivalent to Cochin

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Airport, as determined by AERA (OrderNo.7/2017-18 dated 13.07.2017 for 2nd Control Period), may be allowed on ad hoc basis for the period from Date of Commencement of Cargo Operations at Kannur Airport up to 31st March 2021.

- 1.7 M/s KIAL vide their letter dated 10.08.2020 has proposed to provide all such services currently included in the Tariff Card of Cochin Airport. In addition, KIAL has also proposed to levy customs cost recovery charges at actuals as and when these are invoiced by Customs to Kannur Airport.
- 1.8 It is stated that during FY 2019-20, that is, prior to suspension of air traffic movements due to COVID-19, four airlines, viz., Indigo, Go Air, Air India Express, and, Air India, were operating at Kannur Airport and further that presently air traffic movements have been resumed partially by two Airlines.

2. <u>Authority's Examination</u> :

- 2.1 The Authority examined the proposal of M/s KIAL in the context of the following:
 - (i) AERA determined the aeronautical tariffs for Cochin Airport (CIAL) for 2nd Control Period (FY 2016-21) based on the overall Aggregate Revenue Requirement (ARR), as assessed by the Authority, taking into consideration all aeronautical services, which includes cargo, as AERA considers the same as aeronautical service under the regulations. As such no separate exercise/specific analysis was undertaken by AERA in respect of Cargo services of CIAL while determining tariffs. The cargo tariff as proposed by CIAL was accepted as such in the Tariff Order as a component of overall ARR. The cargo tariffs approved by AERA for Cochin Airport are valid up to 31st March 2021.
 - (ii) The aeronautical tariffs (LPH, X-ray, etc.) for Kannur Airport for the 1st Control Period FY2018-23 (as determined by AERA vide Order no. 26/2018-19 dated 11.09.2018) are the same as the aeronautical tariffs determined for Cochin International Airport (Order no.07/2017-18 for 2nd Control Period). While passing the Tariff Order the Authority has considered and accepted the proposal of Kannur Airport to fix the tariffs at par with Cochin Airport in order to be competitive.
 - (iii) The Authority looked into the tariffs of some airports in the vicinity of Kannur Airport viz. Trivandrum, Calicut, and, found that at these airports the Cargo Services are provided by Independent Service Providers(ISPs) for whom AERA has determined tariff based on their MYTP. Moreover the tariffs of these ISPs at Trivandrum & Calicut airports are not comparable to the tariffs prevailing at Cochin Airport since they do not provide all the cargo services that are provided by Cochin Airport.
 - (iv) The Authority after careful examination is of the view that KIAL can be allowed to charge the tariffs as approved for Cochin Airport by AERA vide Order no.07/2017-18 (01.04.2017 to 31.03:2021), in the interim, till such time KIAL submits a detailed proposal for regular determination.

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(v) Further, the Authority does not agree with M/s KIAL's proposal to charge Customs Recovery Costs from Users. M/s KIAL should impress upon Customs Department to provide customs service free of "customs recovery cost" as is being done at other airports.

ORDER:

- **3.** The Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1)(a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, and the facts and clarifications placed on record before the Authority, decides and orders that :
 - 3.1 M/s Kannur International Airport (KIAL) is allowed to charge the cargo tariffs as approved for Cochin International Airport (CIAL) by AERA (vide Order no.07/2017-18 for CIAL 2nd Control Period) on ad hoc basis from the Date of Commencement of Cargo Operations up to 31st March 2021 or till regular determination of tariffs for FY 2021-22 & FY 2022-23 of First Control Period, whichever, is earlier.
 - 3.2 M/s KIAL is not allowed to charge any Customs Recovery Costs from Users.
 - 3.3 M/s KIAL is advised to file its detailed proposal once the cargo operations are commenced, for regular determination of aeronautical tariffs for the 4th& 5th years of the 1st Control Period. The Airport operator has to submit MYTP proposal before 31.03.2021 for determination of regular cargo charges. The ad hoc tariffs shall be adjusted in the Aggregate Revenue Requirement (ARR) of 1stControl Period (01.04.2018 to 31.03.2023) for KIAL.
 - 3.4 This Order shall be effective from the Date of Commencement of Cargo Services by the Airport Operator M/s Kannur Intl. Airport Ltd.(KIAL) at Kannur Airport.
