Sir,

This is with reference to the Concession Agreement signed on 5th July, 2004 between Government of India, acting through the Secretary, Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA) and Bangalore International Airport Limited (BIAL) for Development, Construction, Operation and Maintenance of Kempegowda International Airport, Bengaluru (KIAB).

2. Bangalore International Airport Limited had requested Government of India for extension of Term of Concession, with the approval of their Board having Chief Secretary, Government of Karnataka (GoK) as its Chairman, by notifying its intentions and decision to exercise its option of extending the term of Concession Agreement for further period of 30 Years as provided in Article No 13.7.1 of the Concession Agreement, vide letter dated 17th September, 2019 (Annexure-I). This request was followed with another representation from BIAL vide letter dated 18th November, 2019 (Annexure-II).

3. The submissions made by BIAL were examined in this Ministry and following have been noted:

i. Article 3.1.1 of the Concession Agreement grants right and privilege (Concession) to BIAL for carrying out the Development, Design, Financing, Construction, Commissioning, Maintenance, Operation and Management of the Airport (excluding the right to carry out the Reserved Activities and to provide communication and navigation surveillance/air traffic management services which are required to be provided by AAI). This Concession Agreement (CA) had been accorded approval of the Union Cabinet on 20th January, 2004.

- ii. As per Article 13.7.1 of CA, unless terminated earlier in accordance with Article 4.3.1, Article 13.4, or by mutual agreement between the Parties in writing, Concession Agreement shall continue in full force and effect from its commencement in accordance with Article 4 of the CA until the thirtieth (30th) anniversary of the Airport Opening Date, whereupon the term of the Agreement shall at the option of BIAL be extended for a further period of thirty (30) years.
- iii. The Airport Opening Date, when the airport project was completed and commenced commercial operations, has been recorded as 24th May, 2008 (**Notification at Annexure-III**), which-in-turn sets the present term of the Concession Agreement upto 23rd May, 2038. As per the provisions of Article 13.7.1, BIAL may at any time prior to the twenty-seventh (27th) anniversary of the Airport Opening Date i.e. 23rd May, 2035, seek extension of the term of the Concession Agreement by another 30 years.
- iv. As per its letter dated 22nd Oct, 2020 (Annexure-IV), BIAL has communicated that extension of CA is very critical to BIAL in view of significant investment being done for the large expansion of the airport and related infrastructure, required to meet the growing demands of aviation sector and economic growth in Karnataka. The extension is also essential from lenders perspective with expectations to have a clear term period available beyond the project loan repayment period for borrowings.

4. In view of the foregoing, MoCA, vide letter No. AV.20015/12/2019-AD dated 26th November, 2019 **(Annexure-V)**, had sought comments /recommendations of the Government of Karnataka (GoK), being an important stakeholder and shareholder in BIAL. GoK, vide letter dated 20th Oct 2020 **(Annexure-VI)** informed MoCA about the GoK's concurrence to the proposal of BIAL for extension of Concession Agreement for a further period of 30 years from 24th May 2038 onward, subject to the conditions as envisaged in GoK Order dated 16th Oct., 2020.

5. GoK, vide Order dated 16th October, 2020 (**Annexure-VII**), accorded its approval for Extension of Concession Agreement for a further period of 30 years from 24th May, 2038 and revision of Land Lease Agreement co-terminus with the Concession Agreement, subject to the following:

- a. The Site Cost to be increased from present Rs.211.78 crores to a maximum of Rs.302.15 crores by including the costs towards Interest paid on HUDCO Loan(capitalized till handing over of the land) & additional compensation as & when paid to the landowners/losers (to be included the payment is made) and made effective from 24.05.2022.
- b. The rate of Annual Increment to the Lease Rental be fixed at 6% per annum in the Extended Concession Period which becomes operational w.e.f. 24.05.2038 (i.e., commencement of the 31styear of the Airport Opening Date of 24.05.2008).
- c. To execute revised Land Lease Agreement for extending the period of concession for a further period of 30 years from 24.05.2038 and subject to (a) & (b), above.
- d. To communicate to Ministry of Civil Aviation, Government of India about the concurrence of Government of Karnataka on the proposal to extend the term of

Concession Agreement for a further period of 30 years from 24.05.2038 onwards.

6. Based on the approval and recommendations of GoK, MoCA sought and received a confirmation from BIAL, vide their letter dated 3rd March 2021 (Annexure-VIII) informing that its Board in its meeting held on 14th August, 2020 had accorded its approval for the revisions/modifications suggested by KSIIDC to Land Lease Agreement (including but not limited to Site cost, rate of annual increment etc.).

7. In view of the above position, Ministry of Civil Aviation, with the approval of the Competent Authority is pleased to extend the term of Concession Agreement with BIAL, as signed on 05th July, 2004 (as amended in 2006), for a further period of 30 years w.e.f. 24th May, 2038, until 23rd May, 2068, in accordance with the provisions contained in Article 13.7.1 of the Concession Agreement. This approval is subject to the following:

- A. Following Articles of Concession Agreement shall have no further force and effect from the thirtieth (30th) anniversary of the Airport Opening Date:
 - i. Article 5.1.2 (Obligations of Gol),
 - ii. Article 5.5 (Existing Airport),
 - iii. Article 7.7 (Commissioning),
 - iv. Article 8.17.2 (Minimum Disruption),
 - v. Article 10.2 (Airport Charges), and
 - vi. Article 15.5 (Change in Law).
- B. The extension of the term will not affect any change in the Rights of Government of India, including the receipt of 4% concession Fee as per Clause 3.3 of CA.
- C. The Definition of Major Airport shall be in accordance with the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008 (as amended from time to time).
- D. BIAL shall adhere to the conditions envisaged by Government of Karnataka's order dated 16th Oct 2020.
- E. BIAL shall fulfill all the requirements as per the Concession Agreement dated 5th July 2004 (as amended in 2006).

Preamble:

The Development, Construction, Operation and Maintenance of a Greenfield International Airport at Bengaluru was taken up under Public Private Partnership (PPP) and is governed by the Concession Agreement which has been entered into between Government of India (GoI), acting through Secretary, Ministry of Civil Aviation and Bangalore International Airport Limited (BIAL) on 05.07.2004. Bangalore International Airport Ltd., M/s BIAL has requested Government of India for extension of Concession of Term of the Concession Agreement and GoI has sought opinion of the GoK. As per Clause 13.7.1 of this Concession Agreement, the Validity of the Concession Agreement is for a period of 30 years from the Airport Opening Date whereupon the term of the Agreement shall at the option of Bangalore International Airport Ltd., M/s BIAL be extended for a further period of 30 years.

2. M/s Bangalore International Airport Ltd., vide its letter dated:17.09.2019 had requested Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA), Government of India (GoI), quoting that for the large expansion of airport and related infrastructure and significant investment required to meet the growing demand in the aviation sector and regional development, an extension in term of Concession Agreement in respect of BIAL be extended for a further period of 30 years. 3. Bangalore International Airport Ltd., M/s BIAL has notified of its intention and decision to exercise its option of extending the term of the Concession Agreement for a further period of 30 years as provided for an Article No.13.7.1 of the Concession Agreement.

4. The Matter has been examined in Government in consultation with the Hon'ble Advocate General, Government of Karnataka and hence the order:

In the circumstances explained in the preamble, after careful examination of the proposal, sanction of the Government of Karnataka is accorded for the following:

a) The Site Cost to be increased from present Rs.211.78 crores to

a maximum of Rs.302.15 crores by including the costs towards. Interest paid on HUDCO Loan (capitalized till handing over of the land) & additional compensation as & when paid to the land owners / losers (to be included the payment is made) and made effective from 24.05.2022.

- b) The rate of Annual Increment to the Lease Rental be fixed at 6% per annum in the Extended Concession Period which becomes operational w.e.f. 24.05.2038 (i.e., commencement of the 31st year of the Airport Opening Date of 24.05.2008).
- c) To execute revised Land Lease Agreement for extending the period of concession for a further period of 30 years from 24.05,2038 and subject to (a) & (b), above.
- d) To communicate to Ministry of Civil Aviation, Government of India about the concurrence of Government of Karnataka on the proposal to extend the term of Concession Agreement for a further period of 30 years from 24.05.2038 onwards.

With reference to the above mentioned subject, we wish to inform that BIAL had requested Government of India ("GoI") through Ministry of Civil Aviation ("MoCA") for extension of the "Term" under the Concession Agreement ("CA") for further period of 30 years from the conclusion / expiry of the initial term of the Concession period.

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It may be noted that the Ministry had requested the Government of Karnataka ("GoK") for its views on the extension of Term under the Concession Agreement by 30 years.

Consequent to this, GoK through Karnataka State Industrial Infrastructure and Development Corporation Limited ("KSIIDC") had proposed certain revision to the Land Lease Agreement, which is co-terminus with the Concession Agreement's extension for a further period of 30 years from 2038 until 2068.

We wish to inform that the Board of Directors of the Company at its meeting held on 14th August, 2020 had accorded their approval for the following revisions/modifications suggested by KSIIDC to Land Lease Agreement:

- a) The revision of the "Site cost" as defined in Schedule C of the Land Lease Deed between KSIIDC and the Company, increasing the site cost from Rs.211.78 Cr., to a maximum of Rs.302.15 Cr., for the purpose of lease rental payable to Karnataka State Industrial Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited ("KSIIDC") to be effective from the Financial year 2022-23.
- b) The rate of annual increment to the Lease rental increase be fixed at 6% per annum in the extended Concession period from 24th May, 2038 to 23rd May, 2068.
