Annual Tariff Proposals submitted by Globe Ground India Limited for providing Ground Handling Services at Bangalore International Airport, Bengaluru

New Delhi: 12th September, 2012

AERA Building Administrative Complex Safdarjung Airport New Delhi – 110 003 The Authority had considered the Multi Year Tariff Proposal (MYTP) for the first control period commencing w.e.f. 01.04.2011 submitted by M/s Globe Ground India (Pvt.) Ltd. (i.e. GGI) providing ground handling services at Bangalore International Airport, and after due stakeholder consultation issued a Multi-Year Tariff Order (MYTO) No. 24/2011-12 dated 13.10.2011 ordering that:

- (i). "The services provided for ground handling by Globe Ground India Private Limited at Bangalore International Airport, are "material but competitive". Hence, the Authority shall adopt a "light touch approach" for determination of tariff for the 1st control period w.e.f. 01.04.2011.
- (ii). Globe Ground India Pvt. Ltd., may submit the Annual Tariff Proposal for the first tariff year of the first control period for the consideration of the Authority within a period of 75 days of the issue of this Order in accordance with the Guidelines."
- 2.1 However, the said approval was subject to the order of **the Hon'ble AERA** Appellate Tribunal in Appeal No. 12/2011 which is reproduced hereunder:

"It is made clear that even if any final order is passed by the respondent - Airports Economic Regulatory Authority, the same shall not be given effect to without leave of this Court."

The said order of the Appellate Tribunal is still in force.

- 2.2 As per clause 11.2 of the "Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Tariff for Services Provided for Cargo Facility, Ground Handling, and Supply of fuel to the Aircraft) Guidelines 2011", the ATP is required to be submitted in the form and manner as provided in Appendix AI.8.2 wherein it is mentioned that the ATP should be supported by:
 - Form B and Form F14(b),
 - Details of consultation with stakeholders
 - Evidence of User Agreements clearly indicating the Tariff (s) proposed by the service Provider.
- 2.3 As per the Guidelines, the ATP is required to be submitted at least 75 days prior to the start of the Tariff Year. In view of GGI not submitting the proposal with in the stipulated time, they were requested to expedite the same vide letter dated 14.03.2012, 30.05.2012 and 14.06.2012. Subsequently, GGI have submitted their first, second and third year tariff proposal vide submission dated 25.06.2012 in respect of the Ground Handling facility at Bangalore International Airport, Bengaluru.
- 2.4 GGI have submitted Form-B, Form-14(b) in the manner as specified in the guidelines. Towards documented evidence of stakeholder consultation GGI have submitted sample agreements with airlines operating at Bangalore Airport and also copy of the award letter from BIAL.

- 2.5 It is observed that GGI have proposed an increase of 10% approximately each year in maximum tariff rates for the second and third tariff year as compared with the maximum tariffs of the first tariff year.
- 3. In Form 14(b), GGI have submitted that:
 - (i) The maximum rates as per Form 14(b) are excluding all taxes such as Service tax and Airport Levies, as may be applicable.
 - (ii) The proposed ATP for Tariff Year 2 and Tariff Year 3 have been increased by 10% on the basis of prevalent rate of inflation
- 4. After careful consideration of the matter and in view of the MYTO issued by the Authority to determine the aeronautical charges under the light touch approach, the Authority decided to make the following proposal for stakeholder consultation:
 - (i) The charges for ground handling service provided by GGI at Bangalore International Airport for the first tariff year (01.04.2011 to 31.03.2012) proposed by GGI may be approved w.e.f. 01.04.2011 or from such other prospective date as the Authority may finally decide. (Annexure I)
 - (ii) The charges for ground handling services provided by GGI at Bangalore International Airport for the second tariff year (01.04.2012 to 31.03.2013) proposed by GGI may be approved w.e.f. 01.04.2012 or from such other prospective date as the Authority may finally decide. (Annexure II)
 - (iii) The charges for ground handling services provided by GGI at Bangalore International Airport for the third tariff year (01.04.2013 to 31.03.2014) proposed by GGI may be approved w.e.f. 01.04.2013 or from such other prospective date as the Authority may finally decide. (Annexure III)
 - (iv) The above rates will be maximum rates exclusive of taxes only.
 - (v) However, the above proposed tariffs will be subject to the order of the **Hon'ble AERA Appel**late Tribunal referred to in para 2.1 above viz. that these charges will not be given effect to without leave of the AERAAT.
- 5. In accordance with the provisions of Section 13(4) of the AERA Act 2008, the proposal contained in para 4 above is hereby put forth for stakeholder consultation. To assist the stakeholders in making their submissions in a meaningful and constructive manner, necessary documents are enclosed as at **Annexure IV**. For removal of doubts, it is clarified that the contents of this Consultation Paper may not be construed as any Order or Direction of this Authority. The Authority shall pass an Order, in the matter, only after considering the submissions of the stakeholders in response hereto and by making such decision fully documented and explained in terms of the provisions of the Act.

6. The Authority welcomes written evidence-based feedback, comments and suggestions from stakeholders on the proposal made in para 4 above, **latest by 26.09.2012** at the following address:






