AERA Building Administrative Complex Safdarjung Airport New Delhi – 110 003 The Authority considered the Multi Year Tariff Proposal (MYTP) submitted by M/s Menzies Aviation Bobba (Bangalore) Pvt. Ltd. (MABB) for the first control period commencing from 01.04.2011, in respect of the tariff for providing cargo facility at Bangalore International Airport, Bengaluru. After stakeholder consultation the Multi Year Tariff Order (MYTO)-Order No. 21/2011-12 dated 16.08.2011 was issued wherein it was decided that:

- (i) The services provided for the cargo facility by Menzies Aviation Bobba (Bangalore) Pvt. Ltd. at Bengaluru Airport are "material but competitive". Hence, the Authority shall adopt a "light touch approach" for determination of tariff for the 1st control period w.e.f. 01.04.2011.
- (ii) MABB may submit the ATP for the first tariff year of the first control period for the consideration of the Authority within a period of 75 days of the issue of this Order in accordance with the Guidelines.
- 2.1 **Further, with reference to Appeal no. 12/2011 filed by BIAL, the Hon'ble** Tribunal vide its order dated 19.10.2011 it was stated that:

"It is made clear that even if any final order is passed by the respondent-Airports Economic Regulatory Authority, the same shall not be given effect to without leave of this court."

- 2.2 The above order dated 19.10.2011, passed by the AERA Appellate Tribunal in Appeal No. 12/2011, is still in force.
- 3. Pursuant to the issue of the Multi Year Tariff Order (MYTO), MABB vide their letter no. Nil dated 29.12.2011 and letter no. Nil dated 21.03.2012 have submitted their Annual Tariff Proposal (ATP) for the Financial Year 2011-12 and FY 2012-13 respectively for their cargo facility at Bangalore Airport, Bengaluru. Additional submissions were made by MABB vide their letter no. NIL dated 10.04.2012.
- 4.1 As per clause 11.2 of the Guidelines, Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Tariff for Services Provided for Cargo Facility, Ground Handling and Supply of Fuel to the Aircraft) Guidelines, 2011 the ATP is required to be submitted in the form and manner as provided in Appendix AI.8.2 wherein it is mentioned that the ATP should be supported by:
 - Form B and Form F14(b),
 - Details of consultation with stakeholders
 - Evidence of User Agreements clearly indicating the Tariff (s) proposed by the service Provider.
- 4.2 MABB have submitted Form-B & Form-14(b) along with copies of e-mail exchanges with the users and a copy of MOU signed between MABB and Domestic Air Cargo Agents Association of India(DACAAI) in support of their first and second year tariff proposals, as documented evidence of stakeholder consultation.
- 5. After careful consideration of the tariff proposals, the Authority makes the following proposal for stakeholder consultation:

- a) The charges proposed by MABB for the first tariff year (01.04.2011 to 31.03.2012) of the first control period may be approved w.e.f 01.04.2011 or such other prospective date as the Authority may decide. (Annexure I)
- b) The charges proposed by MABB for the second tariff year (01.04.2012 to 31.03.2013) of the first control period may be approved w.e.f 01.04.2012 or such other prospective date as the Authority may decide. (Annexure-II)
- 6. In accordance with the provisions of Section 13(4) of the AERA Act, the proposal contained in para 5 above is hereby put forth for stakeholder consultation. To assist the stakeholders in making their submissions in a meaningful and constructive manner, necessary documents are enclosed **(Annexure-III)**. For removal of doubts, it is clarified that the contents of this Consultation Paper may not be construed as any Order or Direction of this Authority. The Authority shall pass an Order, in the matter, only after considering the submissions of the stakeholders in response hereto and by making such decision fully documented and explained in terms of the provisions of the Act.
- 7. The Authority welcomes written evidence-based feedback, comments and suggestions from stakeholders on the proposal made in para 5 above, **latest by 03.07.2012** at the following address:



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of understanding (MOU) is made at Bangalore, India on this 30 th day of May 2011, between:

Menzies Aviation Bobba Bangalore Private Limited, a company incorporated under the laws of India, with its office at Plot No. C-04L, Bengaluru International Airport, Devanahalli, Bengaluru 560300, India (hereinafter referred to as "MABB", which expression shall unless the context requires otherwise include its successors and permitted assigns).


Domestic Air Cargo Agents Association of India, an association registered under the laws of India and having its registered office at L-333, Mahipalpur Extension, New Delhi-110037(hereinafter referred to as "DACAAI" which expression shall unless the context requires otherwise include its successors and permitted assigns); and

MABB and DACAAI shall be individually referred to as Party and collectively as Parties

RECITALS

- A. Whereas MABB is operating and maintaining its Air Cargo Terminal at Bangalore International Airport (BIAL), Bengaluru.
- B. DACAAI is an Association representing domestic air cargo agents with membership of more than 22 agents, the list of registered members along with the details of registration is annexed to this MoU as Annexure A. This list may be modified from time to time and all such modifications shall be duly informed to MABB.







- C Whereas the Terminal Storage Processing charges, as agreed with trade and notified by MABB are in effect since 23rd May, 2008 without any subsequent revision. Refer Annexure B for the existing rates.
- D. As general practice at MABB cargo terminal till the date of this MoU, the Terminal Storage Processing (TSP) and other related charges are notified by MABB, in consultation with trade, and are collected from the respective domestic agents or walk-in-customer at the time of booking or collection of cargo. To facilitate payment, some Domestic Cargo Agents have pre-deposit accounts with MABB for easy cashless payment of charges.
- E. Whereas the cargo agents, represented by DACAAI and the Carriers (hereinafter for ease of reference referred to as "Carrier") have mutually agreed that the Carrier shall pay the TSP charges to the MABB ("Handling Company") with effect from June 1, 2011
- F. Consequent to the above arrangement between DACAAI and the Carrier, DACAAI approached MABB and represented that commencing June 1, 2011 the TSP charges payable by the cargo agents shall be payable by the Carrier and has requested MABB to acknowledge the change in mechanism for levy and collection of domestic Terminal Storage Processing (TSP) charges at MABB cargo terminal.
- G. Whereas as a compensation for the extra administration and risk for the Handling Company due to shift of business from cash to credit, DACAAI, on behalf of domestic cargo handling agents, has offered an increase of 10% on the existing TSP rates.

NOW THEREFORE the Parties hereby agree to the following:

- Based on the representation of the Carrier to pay the TSP charges to the Handling Company and subject to each of the Carriers entering into the attached Addendum to its SGHA, the Handling Company hereby agrees and acknowledges that the Carrier shall be responsible for payment of the TSP charges on behalf of the agent and the agent shall pay to the Carrier TSP charges along with air freight charges.
- The Parties agree and acknowledge that respective cargo agent shall be solely responsible for the cargo before screening in case of outbound cargo and after delivery in case of inbound cargo.
- DACAAI agrees and acknowledges that this arrangement is being facilitated by the Handling Company to facilitate the collection mechanism of terminal charges for the Domestic Air Cargo Agents.
- Consequent to the joint meeting held on 10th November, 2010, DACAAI agrees for an increase of 10% in existing domestic TSP charges effective from June 1, 2011. Minutes of the meeting enclosed as Annexure C.
- 5. DACAAI and each of its agents/members, as the case may be, indemnify, defend and save harmless the Handling Company from and against all claims, default of payments, demands, proceedings, damages and liabilities for loss of or damage to properly or death of or injury to any person and against all associated direct

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costs (including reasonable attorney's fees) losses and expenses, arising out of this arrangement being facilitated by the Handling Company.

- 6. Any revision in TSP charges shall be agreed between Domestic Air cargo Agents Association of India (DACAAI) and MABB and DACAAI or Handling Company shall notify the same to the Carriers. The existing charges agreed and notified by MABB shall form the basis to start the arrangement. The schedule of current services and charges schedule is annexed to this MoU as Annexure 2.
- The charges relating to storage of cargo beyond free period, wherever applicable, shall be billed to the respective agent and collected by MABB at the time of clearance. Clearance of cargo attracting storage charge shall be subject to payment of storage charges in cash or through PDA account.
- In case of non-payment of TSP charges by the Carrier within the agreed credit period as stipulated in the SGHA between the Handling Company and the Carrier, MABB shall subject to clause 10, shift the TSP service from credit billing on Carriers to PDA/Cash billing on agents. MABB would start directly collecting the TSP charges from agents at the time of acceptance and delivery of cargo.
- MABB shall notify to DACAAI, the date from which it would not be able to accept the cargo on credit for that Carrier. This will be pursuant to the Carriers signing their respective agreements with MABB. It would be the responsibility of DACAAI to notify to domestic cargo agents to pay TSP charges in cash or through PDA account at the time of acceptance or delivery of cargo at MABB. Notwithstanding anything herein Handling Company may for unforeseen economic or commercial reasons terminate this arrangement and obtain payment of the TSP charges direct from cargo agents.
- DACAAI shall provide full cooperation and necessary support to MABB for collection of TSP charges from agents and also past outstanding from Carriers, if any. DACAAI will take onus/responsibility of all its member who delay/Default on TSP charges.
