- AERA vide its Order No. 56/2020-21 dated 24.12.2020 had determined the Aeronautical Tariff in respect of Sri Guru Ram Dass Jee International Airport, Amritsar for the 1st Control Period (01.04.2019 to 31.03.2024).
- 2. AAI has prepared the proposal for the Second Control Period (FY 01.04.2024 to 31.03.2029) along with the True-up for the 1st Control Period (01.04.2019 to 31.03.2024) as per AERA methodology. The proposal has been prepared with the actual data for the period 01.04.2019 to 31.03.2023 and projected data for the period 01.04.2023 to 31.03.2029 considering the following:
 - Traffic Data
 - CHQ & RHQ Allocations
 - Employee Ratio
 - Quarter Ratio
 - Regulatory Asset Base
 - Depreciation
 - Fair Rate of Return (FRoR)
 - Operating Cost
 - Non-Aeronautical Revenue
 - Taxation
 - Actual Revenue
 - Aggregate Revenue Required (ARR)
 - Proposed Tariff.
- 3. Based on the above, shortfall has been worked out for 1st Control Period (01.04.2019 to 31.03.2024).
- 4. Total Present Value of Projected Revenue at proposed rates is Rs. 831.69 Crores. It is requested to approve the Proposal.

Multi Year Tariff Proposal (MYTP) submission to Airport Economic Regulatory Authority of India (AERA) for Determination of Tariff for Airport Services in respect of Sri Guru Ram Dass Jee International Airport, Amritsar for the 2nd Control Period (01.04.2024 to 31.03.2029) along with True up of 1st Control Period (01.04.2019 to 31.03.2024).

 Background and Introduction to Sri Guru Ram Dass Jee International Airport, Amritsar

1.1. Background of Airport Authority of India

1.1.1. Airports Authority of India (AAI) was constituted under the Airports Authority of India Act 1994 ("AAI Act") and came into being on 1st April 1995 by merging erstwhile National Airports Authority and International Airports Authority of India, with a view to accelerate the integrated development, expansion and modernization of the air traffic services, passenger terminals, operational areas, and cargo facilities at the airports in the country. The merger brought into existence a single organization entrusted with the responsibility of creating,

upgrading, maintaining, and managing civil aviation infrastructure, both on the ground and air space in the country.

1.2. Overview and History of Sri Guru Ram Dass Jee International Airport

Sri Guru Ram Das Ji International Airport (IATA: ATQ, ICAO: VIAR) is an international airport serving Amritsar, Punjab, India. It is located at Raja Sansi, 11 km (7 mi) north-west from the city centre. It is named after Guru Ram Das, the fourth Sikh Guru and the founder of Amritsar. The airport is the largest and the busiest airport of Punjab. It is a hub of cargo movements, domestically and internationally. The airport is ranked the 6th best regional airport in India and Central Asia in 2019 and 2020 by Skytrax. The airport is awarded as the best airport in Asia-Pacific in 2020 (2 to 5 million passengers per annum) by Airports Council International.

History of Airport: In 1930, the airport was established during the British era, and was used for VVIP movements. After independence, it got connected with Delhi and Srinagar. The first international flight to Kabul was launched in 1960. In January 1982, Air India started a flight from Bombay to Birmingham that stopped in Delhi, Amritsar and Moscow. The service aboard Boeing 707s linked the large North Indian population in the West Midlands to its homeland. The airline terminated it in October 1984 amid the Punjab insurgency.

In May 2005, Air India commenced service to Toronto via Birmingham using Boeing 777s. The stopover changed to London's Heathrow Airport three years later. In October 2010, the carrier replaced the route with a direct flight from its Delhi hub to Toronto. British Midland International (BMI) launched a flight to London-Heathrow via Almaty in October 2011. The company flew the route with an Airbus A330. The link ceased in October 2012 as a consequence of the merger between BMI and British Airways. In February 2018, Air India resumed nonstop service to Birmingham on Boeing 787s.

1.2.1. AERA had issued Tariff order dated 24th December 2020 vide order No.56/2020-21 for the 1st Control Period (01.04.2019 to 31.03.2024).

2. Methodology for Tariff Determination

- 2.1. Methodology / Approach to preparation of MYTP Submission
- 2.1.1. The Authority, vide Order No. 13/ 2010-11 dated 12.01.2011 (referred to as "Airport Order" hereinafter) and Direction No. 5/2010-11 dated 28.02.2011 (referred to as "Airport Guidelines" hereinafter), has issued guidelines to determine tariffs at major airports based on Single Till mechanism. Subsequently, the Authority has amended guidelines vide Order no. 14/2016-17 dated 12.01.2017 to determine future tariffs using Hybrid Till.
- 2.1.2. The tariff determination process consists of true-up of 1st Control Period and determination of building blocks for 2nd Control Period. The Authority proposes to undertake true-up of 1st Control Period and the determination of building blocks for 2nd Control Period under Hybrid Till.
- 2.1.3. The Aggregate Revenue Requirement (ARR) under regulatory framework of Authority is calculated as under

$$ARR_t = (FRoR x RAB_t) + D_t + O_t + T_t - \alpha x NAR_t$$

Where,

t is the Tariff Year in the Control Period;

ARRt is the Aggregate Revenue Requirement for the year t;

FRoR is the fair rate of return for the Control Period;

RAB, is the Aeronautical Regulatory Asset Base for the year t;

D_t is the Depreciation corresponding to the Aeronautical RAB for year t;

Ot is the Aeronautical Operation and Maintenance Expenditure for year t, which include all expenditures incurred by the Airport Operator(s) towards aeronautical activities including expenditure incurred on statutory operating costs and other mandatory operating costs;

T_t is the Tax for the year t, which includes payments by Airport Operator in respect of corporate tax on income from assets/ amenities/ facilities/ services taken into consideration for determination of ARR for year t:

 α is 30% cross subsidy factor for revenue from services other than aeronautical services under Hybrid Till for 2nd Control Period. α was 100% cross subsidy factor under Single Till during First Control Period.

 NAR_t is the revenue from services other than aeronautical services (Non-Aeronautical Revenues or NAR) for year t.

2.1.4. Based on ARR, Yield per passenger is calculated as formula given below:

Yield per passenger(Y) =

Where,

Present Value (PV) of ARR, for a tariff year t is calculated at the beginning of the Control Period and the discounting rate for calculating PV is equal to the Fair Rate of Return determined by the Authority.

 VE_t is the Traffic Volume in a tariff year t as estimated by the Authority.

ARRt is the Aggregate Revenue Requirement for tariff year t.

3. True Up for First Control Period (FCP) - Decision of AERA

3.1.1. As per the Chapter 17 of AERA's decision, it is mentioned that the True-up of 1st Control period will be settled at the time of Tariff determination of 2nd control period.

4. True Up of First Control Period (FCP)

4.1. Overview

4.1.1. The Airports Authority of India has trued up 1st Control Period (2019-20 to 2023-24) with respect to Amritsar Airport.

4.2. Traffic

4.2.1. As per Decision No. 4.9 (page 24) of Order No. 56/2020-21, the Authority had decided: Decision No. 4.9.1 "The Authority decides to consider the ATM and passenger traffic as per Table 11".

Decision No. 4.9.2 The Authority decides that subject to the terms and conditions of the privatization of Amritsar Airport, it will consider to 'true-up' the traffic volume (ATM and Passengers) on the basis of actual traffic in Ist Control Period while determining tariffs for the 1st Control Period.

4.2.1.1. Significant reason for increase/ decreases in Traffic are as follows

- 4.2.1.1.1. Fall in ATM and Passenger for FY 2019-20 and FY 2020-21 was due to Pandemic Covid-19.
- 4.2.1.1.2. Actual Pax Domestic Traffic in F.Y. 2022-23 and 2023-24 is higher as compared to AERA projections. In case of International Traffic for the F.Y. 2022-23 and 2023-24 traffic is less than AERA Projections. But, if compared with the Total Pax traffic for 2022-23 and 2023-24 actual traffic is higher as compared to approved traffic.
- 4.2.1.1.3. Actual ATM Domestic Traffic in F.Y. 2022-23 and 2023-24 is higher as compared to AERA projections. In case of International ATM Traffic for the F.Y. 2022-23 and 2023-24 is near about AERA Projections. But, if compared with the Total Pax traffic for 2022-23 and 2023-24 actual traffic is higher as compared to approved traffic.

5. Allocation of Assets between Aeronautical and Non-Aeronautical

- 5.1 For the allocation of assets, expenditure between aeronautical and non-aeronautical services, Airports Authority of India had divided assets into aeronautical, non-aeronautical and common components. Common components have further been segregated into aeronautical and non-aeronautical assets by applying one of the following three ratios:
- 5.2 Terminal Area Ratio- Ratio of Aeronautical area to Non-Aeronautical area (For terminal related assets).
 - Table 4: Terminal Building Ratio as approved by AERA for 1st Control period as per para No. 5.7.5, the Authority decides to revise the allocation ratio as shown in table below:

- i) Actual Space allotted to agencies.
- ii) Fall in Terminal Building Non-Aeronautical Ratio is due to decrease in the Space rented during 2020-21 to 2022-23 due to Pandemic Covid-19. Also there is an additional increase of 4329 Sqm in Terminal Building Area due to Construction of Canopy in 2019-20.
- iii) # in the recent Tariff Orders of Patna and Bhubaneshwar airports issued by AERA, it is observed that the income from Space Rented to Airlines has been considered as Aeronautical Income by AERA. But on the other hand, Space allotted to Airlines has not been considered as aero space. Now, in Amritsar MYTP the income received from airlines is treated as aero income on the same lines as decided by AERA in the matter of Patna and Bhubaneshwar airports tariff determination. Also, the Sapce allotted to Airlines has been considered as space for aeronautical activities. Hence, Terminal Building Ratio has been changed.
- 5.2.2 Residential Quarters Ratio- Ratio of staff providing ANS service staying in Residential Building to staff providing aeronautical service staying in residential building.

Administration and General expenses -Non CHO/RHQ

AERA had considered a nominal increase @10%, whereas AAI has taken as actual expenditure.
 Moreover, additional five Revenue expenditure contracts i.e. May I Help You, Solid waste Management,
 Breathe analyser, Bird Chasing and Pest control expenditure have been awarded from 2019-20 which
 includes renewal of the contracts also. AAI has spent less amount of expenditure as compared to the
 approved expenditure of AERA.

Administration and General expenses - CHO/RHO

AERA had considered a nominal increase @5%, whereas AAI has taken as actual. AAI had appointed
M/s ICMAI MARF Institute, New Delhi to study the efficiency of the existing process of allocation of
CHQ/ RHQ expenses and to propose new methodology/process CHQ/ RHQ expenses. On the basis of
Final report Submitted by the Institute, figures pertaining to Amritsar Airport have been considered.

Repairs and Maintenance

AERA had projected growth in the range of 10.21% and 21.50% during 1st control period.

Following are the reasons for variance in the actual cost are given below:

R&M (Civil):

Actual R&M expenses have been considered during the 1st Control period. Some of the Special Repair (Civil) executed for a sum of Rs. 3.82 Crores which are in addition to regular R&M works during 1st CP. These special repairs include:

- i) Special repair of Airside Curtain wall and Gable end, bull nose ACP by replacement of sealant in Terminal Building of SGRDJI Airport, Amritsar.
- ii) Repair and refilling of joints in apron area at SGRDJ International Airport, Amritsar
- iii) Repair and Painting of City side Boundary and Ancillary Building at SGRDJI Airport, Amritsar.

R&M (Electrical):

Actual R&M expenses have been considered during the 1st Control period.

R&M (Vehicle):

Actual R&M expenses have been considered during the 1st Control period.

R&M (Furniture & Fixtures):

Actual R&M expenses have been considered during the Ist Control period.

R&M Electronics:

Actual R&M expenses have been considered during the 1st Control period.

Utilities and outsourcing expenses

An amount of Rs. 37.62 Crores was proposed by AERA under this Expense Head. AAI, in the true-up of 1st CP submits the expenditure to the tune of Rs. 46.19 Crores. AERA had projected growth in the range of 0.87% to 11.90% during 1st control period. The overall increase in Actual expenditure as compared to AERA proposed expenditure is 23% appox. which is mainly due to actual amount of Electricity and Consultancy Charges paid by AAI.

Other outflows - Collection Charges on UDF:

- Collection charges on UDF is directly linked with Passenger growth and AERA had taken higher growth for the 1st Control Period.
- Actual figures have been considered.

<u>Taxation</u>

10.1 AERA had considered Amritsar airport on standalone basis as it has done for other AA1 airports as well.
