Subject: Proposal for CP No. 01/2017-18 MYTP and ATP for 2nd CP of IOSL, Mumbai ITP

This refers to Consultation Paper No. 01/2017-18 dated 09th October, 2017 issued by your office with respect to MYTP proposal for second control period of M/s IOSL towards ITP operations at Mumbai Airport.

As the other ITP operator at Mumbai Airport, we are in full agreement with justifications for increase in ITP tariff submitted by M/s Indian Oil Sky Tanking Limited. The escalation in overall operational expenditure besides additional cost of manpower necessitates upward revision of tariff.

Furthermore, initially it was envisaged that each ITP operation would be allotted a consolidated piece of land to establish ITP Operation. Unfortunately due to space constraint, MIAL is unable to offer a single piece of land; hence we are constrained to operate from different locations and thus enhancing the operating costs.

We also request the honourable authority to also expedite BSSPL's Consultation Paper for Mumbai ITP so that the revised ITP tariff of both ITP Operators become effective from a common date.
