Structuring and Operationalizing of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India

The Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India (AERA), has been established by the Government of India, to regulate tariff for aeronautical services rendered at major airports in India, determine other airport charges and to monitor the performance standards of such airports. AERA has been established so as to create a level playing field; to foster healthy competition amongst all major airports; and to encourage investment in airport facilities.

AERA, invites proposals from a qualified and experienced Consultant to assist it in the following areas:

- i. Structuring of the AERA - Designing organisational structure and staff responsibilities including capacity building of AERA;
- ii. Define systems, process and procedures for enabling AERA to carry out its regulatory functions;
- iii. Assist in stakeholder consultations with respect to the recommendations made at clause (ii) above and modifying and altering the same, if required;
- iv. Translating the recommendations regarding the processes and procedures after stakeholder consultations into legally binding document(s) like rules and regulations for implementation and enforcement;
- v. Hand holding support.
